Brownish foam on Upper Lake, conservationists raise eyebrows

Pollution control board attributes it to water hyacinths secretion; collect water sample

BHOPAL

Brownish foam floating on Upper Lake has posed a major concern for agencies looking after lake conservation in Bhopal. Madhya Pradesh Pollution Control Board (MPPCB) will collect water samples for testing.

MPCB regional officer Brijesh Sharma said, "Foam has been noticed for the last couple of years during this period. Foam is because of secretion from aquatic plants like water hyacinths.

We will collect water



sample for testing. Previously, we tested water

sample anticipating detergents coming from residen-

tial colonies but test was negative. We anticipated that

sources of foam may be household cleaning products that contain synthetic surfactants, house paint, pesticides used on lawns or fields, or motor oils running off impervious surfaces."

Naturally occurring foam can be off-white, or brownish and can have a fishy or earthy odour. It's formed by dissolved organic matter, usually dissolved organic carbon (DOC). DOC results from the breakdown of organic debris such as sticks, leaves and watershed soils that hold organic materials, MPPCB official added.

Journalists Federation submits memorandum seeking safety

The Journalists Federation of Sironj, led by President Rohitashv Sharma, submitted a memorandum to the district administration on Thursday, advocating for a journalist safety law. The federation members visited the tehsil office to present the memorandum to SDM Hasharl Chaudhary.

In the memorandum addressed to the Governor, the federation highlighted the tragic shooting of journalist



Salman Ali on September 17 in the Sarangpur tehsil of Rajgarh district by unknown assailants. Two days later, the police are yet to apprehend the suspects, creating a sense of insecurity among journalists. The federation noted that there have been previous instances of life-threatening at-

tacks on journalists in Madhya Pradesh, yet a journalist safety law has not been enacted.

The memorandum demanded the swift arrest of Salman Ali's killers, the provision of 71 crore in compensation to his family, and the immediate implementation of a journalist safety law in the state.

Husband-wife commit fraud of Rs 30L, sell mortgaged plot

A man and his wife, both of whom are builders, allegedly committed a fraud of Rs 30 lakh by selling their plot, which was mortgaged in a bank. A doctor had purchased the plot from the bank via auction and after the fraud came to light, he filed a court case. The court on Friday directed Shahpura police to register a case of fraud against the accused duo.

Investigating officer at Shahpura police station Upendra Singh said complainant Dr Chadrashekhhar Singh, a resident of Mumbai, had ear-

lier purchased a plot through an auction held by a bank. The plot was located in Khanuja Enclave of Shahpura.

When he went to obtain possession of plot, he was told that owners of the plot named Ravindra Khanuja and his wife Paramjeet Khanuja had already sold the plot to someone else. The accused duo even got its registry done in the name of the person who had purchased it from them. After the doctor filed a court case and appeared for hearing, the court on Friday directed Shahpura police to register an FIR against accused duo and the bank manager Kailash Ahirwar.
