

Yogi asks society to stay alert, unite against divisive forces

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GORAKHPUR: Chief minister Yogi Adityanath on Saturday warned society against divisive forces.

Stating that national solidarity would face significant challenges in the absence of social integration and the persistence of casteism and untouchability, he urged people to remain united and work for the betterment of society and the nation.

In a veiled attack, without naming anyone directly, the chief minister said some individuals within the country are being used as instruments by divisive forces and the funding comes from elsewhere. He emphasised the importance of understanding the messages of the Sant Samaj.

"The country's impressive progress is encouraging, and in such circumstances, it is our duty to be cautious of divisive forces," he said.

He was addressing a gathering on the last day of a week-

long programme commemorating the death anniversaries of Mahant Digvijayanath and Mahant Avidyanath at the Gorakhnath temple. Yogi described Mahant Avidyanath as a religious figure who was gentle at heart but firm against those involved in anti-religious activities.

He highlighted the contributions of the Nath sect, stating it has worked to integrate society and bridge the caste divide for centuries. He added that his mentors dedicated their lives to religion and the nation.

Union minister of state for rural development Kamlesh Paswan also paid tribute to Mahant Avidyanath, mentioning that his father Om Prakash Paswan learned the basics of politics from the Mahant.

Uttar Pradesh minister Swatantra Dev Singh praised Yogi Adityanath for realising Mahant Avidyanath's vision and creating a sense of security among residents of Uttar Pradesh.

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VARANASI: As many as 12 lakh or 1.2 million 'diyas' (lamps) will illuminate Kashi's 84 ghats, ponds and tanks on the occasion of Dev Deepawali, a spectacle that draws tourists from India and abroad every year, causing hotels, guesthouses, boats, and cruises to be fully booked during the festival.

This year, Dev Deepawali falls on November 15.

Giving the occasion an eco-friendly touch, around 2.5 to 3 lakh of these lamps will be made from cow dung, according to Rajendra Kumar Rawat, deputy director of the tourism



department.

The Yogi Adityanath government has already declared Dev Deepawali a provincial fair, enhancing its grandeur and spiritual significance.

In addition, a laser show will depict the story of Ganga Avtaran and Shiva Mahima on the ghats.

Furthermore, there will be a display of eco-friendly, green fireworks on the sandbanks across the Ganga, spread-

Entire Gandhi family is against reservation: BJP SC Morcha chief

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LUCKNOW: Attacking the Congress on the issue of reservation, Bharatiya Janata Party SC Morcha president Lal Singh Arya on Saturday said the entire Gandhi family is anti-reservation and this has been proved by Congress leader Rahul Gandhi's recent statement in the US.

"Congress has always been against reservation. Its leaders have time and again proved this by giving statements against reservation," Lal Singh Arya told media persons here on Saturday.

"Entire Gandhi family is against reservation. Right from Jawaharlal Nehru to Indira Gandhi and Rajiv Gandhi, all were against reservation," he added. "Now, Rahul Gandhi has proved that he is also against reservation," the BJP leader said.

He also said the policies of the Congress have always been against reservation. Continuing his attack, Arya said: "Congress misused the Constitution 90 times by dismissing various state governments during its rule."

U.P. pushes energy efficient appliance scheme for staff

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LUCKNOW: The Uttar Pradesh government has directed all heads of departments to take necessary action in support of the newly launched "Government Employees Appliance Scheme on Energy Efficiency" in a way that all government personnel embrace it.

Initiated by Energy Efficiency Services Ltd (EESL), a Central government enterprise, the scheme aims to promote the adoption of energy-efficient appliances among government employees.

A government order (GO) issued by the energy department here on September 17, emphasises the need for popularising the scheme among employees of the Central and state governments, as well as public sector enterprises (PSEs) through awareness about energy conservation.

EESL has created an exclusive e-commerce portal <https://eeslmart.in>, offering a range of high-quality energy-efficient appliances such as LED bulbs, BLDC (brushless direct current) fans, air conditioners and induction cooktops.

These products, marked with the Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE) 5-star rating, are available to government employees at discounted prices throughout the year.

To make a purchase at specially offered rates, employees have to login to EESLmart.in through their whitelisted GOV/NIC or organisation specific email IDs through OTP verification; select appliances, review specifications and warranty terms and, furnish name, mobile number and shipping address.

Upon a successful transaction, a confirmation is sent to employees over email and mobile and the appliance is delivered through our logistics partners.

EESL will whitelist all the government and PSU domain IDs known to it (for example nic.in; gov.in; ntpc.co.in; nbdcl.co.in etc) so that any employee having email IDs on these domains can avail the specially offered prices for all EE appliances available on EESLmart.in.

"With India committing to doubling the rate of energy efficiency under its G20 presidency and in preparation for the COP28 summit, the GovE-asEE scheme aims to drive greater energy savings in the domestic sector. While industries have adopted energy efficiency as a cost-saving measure, EESL believes more awareness and adoption are needed in homes," an energy department official said.
