

CJI flags misuse of AI; to hear plea for guidelines on its use in judiciary

NEW DELHI, NOVEMBER 10

Flagging the misuse of artificial intelligence, Chief Justice of India BR Gavai said he was aware of a morphed video circulating on social media that falsely showed a shoe-throwing incident in his courtroom.

"Even this court is using AI, but the ills are such... We are aware of it; we have seen the morphed video of us (two)," a Bench of Chief Justice of India BR Gavai and Justice K Vinod Chandran said while agreeing to hear after two weeks a petition seeking guidelines to regulate the use of AI tools in the judiciary.

On October 6, advocate Rakesh Kishore (71) allegedly attempted to hurl a shoe towards the CJI in his courtroom. The Bar Council of India had suspended his licence with immediate effect. The petitioner's counsel cautioned against unchecked adoption of AI tools in court processes and sought a policy to govern its use in judiciary.

Respond to PIL on women quota in Parl: SC to Centre

Describing women as the largest minority in the country, the Supreme Court on Monday asked the Centre to respond to a PIL seeking implementation of the Nari Shakti Vandan Act, 2023, which reserved one-third seats for women in the Lok Sabha, state assemblies and Delhi Assembly, including those reserved for SCs and STs.

"Preamble (to the Constitution) says (all citizens are entitled to) political and social equality. Who is the largest minority in this country? It's the woman — almost 48 per cent. This is about political equality of women," a Bench of Justice BV Nagarathna and Justice R Mahadevan said, issuing a notice to the Centre.

The order came after senior advocate Shobha Gupta submitted on behalf of petitioner Jaya Thakur that it was unfortunate that women had to

move the top court for proper political representation after 75 years of Independence.

Noting that enforcement of the law was the prerogative of the executive and that no mandamus could be issued in these matters, Justice Nagarathna said, "Courts have limitations when interfering with such policy matters."

"When is the delimitation exercise there? Serve it to the government," the Bench

said, issuing the notice to the government.

Passed by the Lok Sabha on September 20, 2023, and by the Rajya Sabha on September 21, 2023, the Constitution (106th Amendment) Act, which added Article 334A to the Constitution, received the President's assent on September 28, 2023. The Act was notified thereafter on September 28, 2023.

According to Article 334A, reservation for women in the Lok Sabha and state legislative assemblies will come into effect only after a delimitation exercise was carried out following the conduct of the first Census after the amendment. The quota for women in the Lok Sabha and state assemblies would continue for 15 years and Parliament can later extend it.

However, Thakur has sought implementation of the Act without waiting for a fresh delimitation exercise, saying the constitutional amendment cannot be put on hold for an indefinite period.

9 killed, 24 hurt as...

NDA government came to power in 2014. Fifteen persons were killed in a terror attack at the Delhi High Court on September 7, 2011. Harkat-ul-Jihad al-Islami had claimed responsibility for the attack, which was believed to have been carried out with the backing of Indian Mujahideen. Shah has called a high-level meeting of all heads of investigative agencies on Tuesday morning to take stock of the probe. In the meeting, it was also discussed any possible conspiracy angle behind the incident.

As the Haryana-registered i20 car registration went up in flames, several vehicles in its proximity caught fire. The intensity of the blast was such that the Red Fort metro station's glass panels were shattered, said officials.

Meanwhile, high alert has been sounded in the Delhi-NCR region and several other parts of the country, including Bihar, which is set to vote in the second and final round of Assembly elections tomorrow.

The Delhi Fire Department received a call related to the incident at 6.55 pm and around eight fire tenders were sent to the spot. They controlled the fire from the damaged vehicles on reaching the spot while the injured were taken to the nearby Lok Nayak Jai Prakash Narayan (LNJP) hospital, sources said.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi took stock of the situa-

tion in a conversation with Shah and issued necessary directions to all concerned. "Condolences to those who have lost their loved ones in the blast. May the injured recover at the earliest. Those affected are being assisted by authorities," said the PM.

In a televised address later, the Union Home Minister said, "Around 7 pm, a blast occurred in a Hyundai i20 car at the Subhash Marg traffic signal near the Red Fort in Delhi. The blast injured some pedestrians and damaged some vehicles. Preliminary reports indicate that some people have lost their lives."

Shah said the NSG and NIA teams, along with the FSL, had now begun a thorough investigation. "Orders have been given to examine all nearby CCTV cameras. I have also spoken to the Delhi Police Commissioner and the Special Branch in-charge. We are exploring all possibilities and will conduct a thorough investigation, taking all possibilities into account. All options will be investigated immediately and we will present the results to the public," he said.

Med board opinion on disability can't be junked without evidence: HC

Dismissing a bunch of about 40 appeals filed by the Centre against disability benefits granted to soldiers by the Armed Forces Tribunal (AFT), the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh has ruled that opinions made by medical boards in such cases should ordinarily prevail unless these are contradicted by cogent medical evidence.

Stating that the benefit of reasonable doubt must be extended to the claimant, a Division Bench comprising Justice Sanjay Parihar and Justice Sanjeev Kumar held that that the onus of proof largely lies with the authorities and the claimant shall not be called upon to prove the conditions of entitlement, except in cases where claims are filed 15 years after discharge from service.

The Bench said defence personnel suffering from disabilities due to service conditions, including those arising within 10 years after retirement, may qualify for disability pension if the disease was attributable to service factors.

It made an analysis of the pensionary provisions from the Entitlement Rules, 1982, to the comprehensive framework of 2008, which classified cases of death or disability into five categories.

UP to make Vande Mataram recital must in schools

The BJP-led Uttar Pradesh will make the singing and rendition of national song Vande Mataram compulsory in all schools and colleges of the state. UP Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath made the announcement in Gorakhpur on Monday.

He was presiding over an event to mark the 150th birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. The anniversary coincides with the commemoration of 150 years of the national song.

Noting that no individual, faith or community was greater than the country, Yogi harked back to pre-Independence times to accuse the then Congress of dilutions in the original text of Vande Mataram, a poem which Bankim Chandra Chatterjee first wrote in 1875. It was later published as part of Chatterjee's epic novel Anand-math in 1882.
